Ensuring the safety of your lone workers operating in areas outside of cellular coverage has become simpler than ever with the Spot Gen4. The Spot Gen4 is one of the health and safety devices offered by Smartrak to provide a personalised solution to lone workers operating in areas outside of cellular reception.

The Spot Gen4 is an IP68 personalised solution for lone workers, and with its emergency alert button can trigger an emergency response anywhere in Australia and New Zealand via the GlobalStar satellite network, as long as there is a clear view of the sky.

Benefits

- Satellite communication ensures coverage anywhere in Australia and New Zealand – no cellular coverage required
- Manual SOS feature covers a wide range of emergency and at-risk scenarios
- Check-in feature enables updates of location when outside of cellular coverage
- Manually activated location 'breadcrumb' ensures privacy for staff
- Powered by consumer grade AAA Batteries that are easily accessible and allow for quick replacement by users in the field.

How it Works

- Operates in standby mode until features are activated
- 'Breadcrumb' manually activated to provide an updated location to the Smartrak map every 10 minutes
- Help/SOS alert activated manually by the press of a button, sending notification and location information to the Smartrak map

Key Features

- GlobalStar satellite network coverage
- Button guard stops accidental alert activation
- One button to Check-In
- Location updates stop when user stops moving
- Emergency activation sends an alert via Satellite with the location of the device
- AAA Battery powered for on-the-go replacement

- Lanyard with carabiner
- 4x AAA Energiser Lithium batteries

- Check-in feature allows user to provide regular updates of their status outside of cellular coverage
- Power saving mode automatically activates when unit isn't moving, to preserve battery life
